### **Where is advanced packet pick-up?**

Sunday, May 10: 7:00am until launch time @ Wings Over the Rockies

### **What time does the race start?**

Launch time is 8:00am.

We recommend arriving 30-45 minutes early to check in, gear up, and get ready for the countdown to launch.

Water will be available along the course at Great Lawn Park and at the finish line.

### **Does registration include museum access?**

Participants receive 25% off museum admission when you show your race bib - perfect for our crew to explore aviation and space after the race. Bonus - it's Mother's Day, so why not treat mom to an out-of-this-world experience.

### **Where is the post-run fun?**

Welcome to Moon Base!

After you cross the finish line, the mission isn't over, it's just getting started. Head straight into Moon Base for a high-energy, space-themed celebration designed for all ages.

Enjoy immersive photo ops and hands-on aerospace experiences brought to you by Wings Over the Rockies, along with a lively vendor park featuring 20+ local partners, businesses, and interactive activations.

Bring the whole crew, there are plenty of child-friendly games and activities to keep young astronauts engaged, plus opportunities to explore, play, and learn. Be sure to come in costume, you'll fit right in among fellow runners decked out in everything from astronauts to aliens.

Don't forget to check your race bib for exclusive coupons and offers from restaurants and spots adjacent to the race, perfect for refueling after your mission.

From start to finish, Moon Base is your landing zone for fun, community, and a truly out-of-this-world post-run experience.

### **Where can I park?**

Ample parking is available for runners and spectators! You are welcome to park in any of the following areas:

Wings Over the Rockies: The parking lot on the west side of the museum.

Great Lawn Park: Public parking spaces located at the park.

Street Parking: Available throughout the surrounding neighborhood. Please pay close attention to all posted City of Denver parking signs to avoid any tickets or towing.

### **Are dogs and baby strollers welcome?**

Absolutely—this mission is K9 and family friendly!

Well-mannered, friendly, leashed dogs are welcome to join the space crew.

Strollers are also welcome, and children riding in strollers do **not** need to be registered.

*\*Participants who choose to bring a dog to the Space Race do so at their own risk. All dogs must be properly restrained on a leash at all times and under the control of their owner or handler.*

*By attending the event with a dog, the owner/handler agrees to assume full responsibility and liability for any and all injuries, damages, or losses caused by or related to their dog, including but not limited to injury to other participants, spectators, or property.*

*Wings Over the Rockies is not responsible for the care, supervision, injury, illness, or loss of any dog attending the event. Owners are solely responsible for ensuring their dog is well-behaved, non-aggressive, and suitable for a crowded public environment.*

*Wings Over the Rockies reserves the right to require the removal of any dog exhibiting aggressive or unsafe behavior at any time.*

*By bringing a dog to the event, the owner/handler agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Wings Over the Rockies, its officers, employees, volunteers, and affiliates from any claims, demands, damages, or liabilities arising out of or related to the dog's presence or actions.*

*We'll have hydration stations along the course, but for our four-legged participants, we strongly encourage you to bring extra water to keep them comfortable and safe. Every pup is different, and having your own supply ensures they stay hydrated and happy from liftoff to landing.*
